These gorgeous goblets, known as *tipetti*, are the latest offering from La DoubleJ, the delightful Italian brand founded by fashion editor J.J. Martin. The company launched in 2015 with vintage clothing and jewelry and has since expanded to include ready to wear (like the Getting My Croissant Dress who doesn't need one of those?), swimwear, and

La DoubleJ Housewives tabletop items, all featuring the colorful prints that have become La DoubleJ's signature. For the *tipetti* project, Martin collaborated with Salviati, the legendary 159-year-old Venetian glassmaking house, and drew inspiration from 17th century designs found in the Murano glass museum. The result is this limited-edition collection, handmade using ancient Venetian techniques, and available through lajoublej.com. Each glass is \$4,900. Dishwasher safe? Definitely not. La Dolce Vita approved? Of course!
